Halkirk to Dornoch**

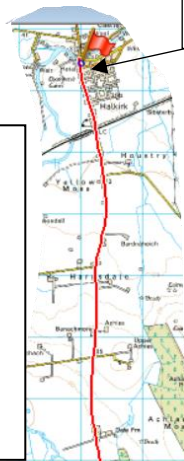
(using parts of John O'Groats Trail and Northern Pilgrim's Way)

Give thanks for the water which sustains life and pray for those affected by drought or without clean water around this world.



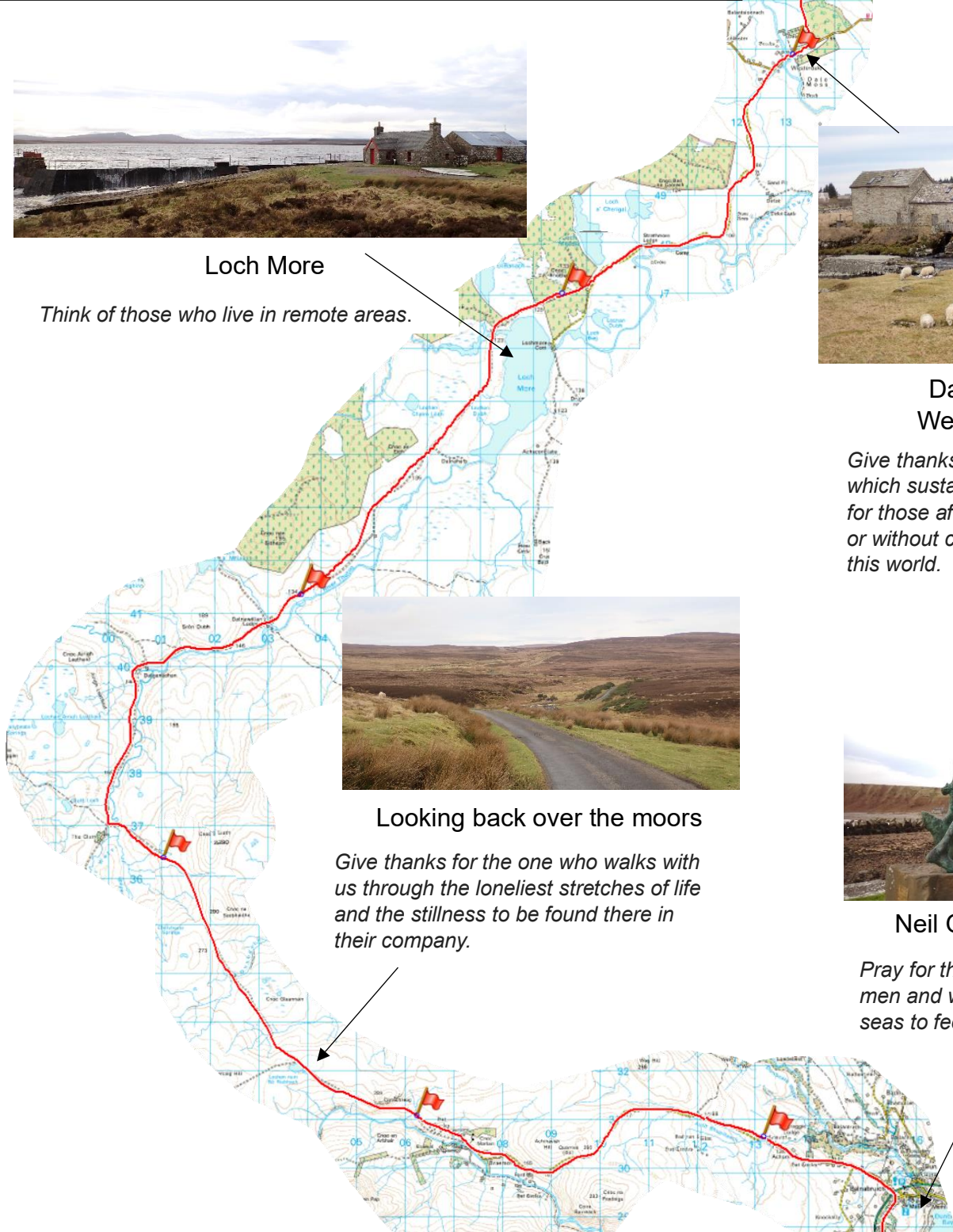
Looking back over the moors
